- No responsibility will be accepted by Eastington Agricultural Show, their stewards, or other assistants for anything that may happen to competitors, their assistants or any members of the public, their property or animals in connection with or arising out of this show. It shall be a condition of entry that each competitor agrees to indemnify the show against any legal action arising thereof.
- All dogs must be kept on a lead.
- All children under 12 years of age, and not competing, must be supervised.
